CSM Sean T. Watson entered the United States Army as an Infantryman on 12 July 1983. He attended One Station Unit Training (OSUT) and Airborne School at Fort Benning, GA. He then volunteered and served in the newly activating 3rd Ranger Battalion at Fort Benning, GA.

CSM Watson has served in the following leadership positions: Team Leader, Squad Leader, Weapons Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, Assistant Operations Sergeant, First Sergeant, Battalion and Brigade Command Sergeant Major. He has also served as a Primary Leadership Development Course instructor, instructor to senior Noncommissioned Officers at the Infantry School in Singleton, Australia, and as a Ranger Indoctrination Program (RIP) and Ranger Orientation Program (ROP) instructor.
