



Lieutenant Colonel Sean Fisher 4th Battalion, 70th Armored Regiment Battalion Commander

LTC Sean Fisher began his U.S. Army service by enlisting in the Army National Guard as a Military Policeman in 1989. While serving with the 214th Military Police Company, LTC Fisher participated in Operations Desert Shield and Storm as part of the 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment. LTC Fisher was commissioned in August 1993 as a graduate of Auburn University.

His first assignment was with the 3rd Battalion, 69th Armor at Fort Stewart, Georgia where he served as a Tank Platoon Leader and Tank Company Executive Officer. LTC Fisher's next assignment was at Fort Hood, Texas with the 3rd Battalion, 66th Armor where he served as an Assistant S3 and Alpha Company Commander. He then served at Fort Knox, Kentucky where he commanded Alpha Troop, 1st Squadron, 16th Cavalry and later served as a Small Group Instructor and Team Chief for the Armor Captain's Career Course in 3rd Squadron, 16th Cavalry. LTC Fisher's next assignment was in Heidelberg, Germany where he served with V Corps as a G3 Battle Major and Executive Officer to the V Corps Chief of Staff. He next served in Hohenfels, Germany as the S3 and Executive Officer of the 1st Battalion, 4th Infantry. Subsequently, he served as the Deputy Task Force Observer/Controller/Trainer for the Warhog Team. LTC Fisher's most recent assignment was as a Military Professor of Joint Military Operations at the Naval War College in Newport, RI.

LTC Fisher's operational and deployment experiences include Operations: Desert Shield, Desert Storm, Intrinsic Action, Vigilant Warrior, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom.

LTC Fisher's military education includes: the Armor Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Combined Arms Services and Staff School and the Command and General Staff College. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Auburn University and a Masters Degree in Political Science from American Military University.
